The Alder: Our Select Private Family Farewell with a Burial Service to include the wider circle

An intimate initial funeral service, processing from home to our 48 seat Service Hall (number of mourners to be advised at the time of need), to share a gentle farewell in the presence of the coffin and relatives and friends – with all the time you need. The Burial takes place after procession to the Crematorium where the wider circle may pay their respects.

This funeral includes:

- Arrangement during business hours at home or at our premises and liaison on your behalf with GPs
- A wood veneer dignified, fully furnished coffin
- Purchase of new grave plot and opening for one
- Solid oak marker cross with engraved plate
- All care, professional services and all third party fees
- Our classic motor hearse, one family limousine, procession from home and to the Cemetery and full staff
- The services of our Celebrant (Christian or Humanist)
- An online tribute page to keep and share for notice, donations, memories, virtual candles
- Designed, printed Order of Service x 60
- Enlarged keepsake photograph & life story photo stream
- Purchase & preparation of your music choices
- Webcast service for distant family to participate
- Single roses for family & wooden shapes for children
- Hand crafted flower cards with orders from our florist
- Access to free professional counselling
- A December invitation to place Memorial Stars on our English trees of memory
- An invitation the following year to attend our Memorial Woodland Planting where your loved one's name will be read out and where the ashes from the stars of memory will be buried with the roots of the trees.

Total Cost

£3,449 (open coffin where grave with space exists)

£4,651 (open coffin plus purchase of new grave plot)

With prior viewing for you to spend time with your loved one.

Key access is given after the initial visit to allow you unrestricted access. Full embalming and restoration is included.

£3,304 (closed coffin where grave with space exists)

£4,491 (closed coffin plus purchase of new grave plot)

Options and what is not included

- A newspaper notice is not included – allow £150 approx if you wish to add this on
- Floral tributes are not included but we have our own florist who is able to help with your choices.
- Additional limousines may be added at £190 per limousine
- Removal of existing headstone where applicable will be quoted by our mason following survey

How the Funeral is invoiced

A deposit of £1,750 is required four days prior to the funeral. If payment is to be settled in full via guaranteed funds, the deposit may be waived.

DWP Funeral Claims are not guaranteed and the deposit is required in such cases, along with the agreement of a guarantor who will settle the balance should the claim be refused. Funeral Finance is available to help spread the cost via our specialist loan company. Please do ask about this.
